New, more appealing color schemes

Now compatible with Word 2010

Assessment Scores Module

- Easier to configure
- New option to display only those scores that are not acceptable
- Ability to display Assessment Scores in WordPad – very useful when using WWB without a printer
- Ability to control which scores are displayed, set goals, and turn on or turn off tracking writing scores from single network file
- New plug-in for Excel that can provide a writing mechanics score based on your criteria

Diction / Pet Peeves

- Common contractions now flagged as a default but can be removed for less formal writing
- Double negatives now flagged – for example, “not unlikely” vs. “likely”
- Specific (actual and actually) words and phrases flagged
- Ability to add short pet peeves – for example, “RU” or “LOL”

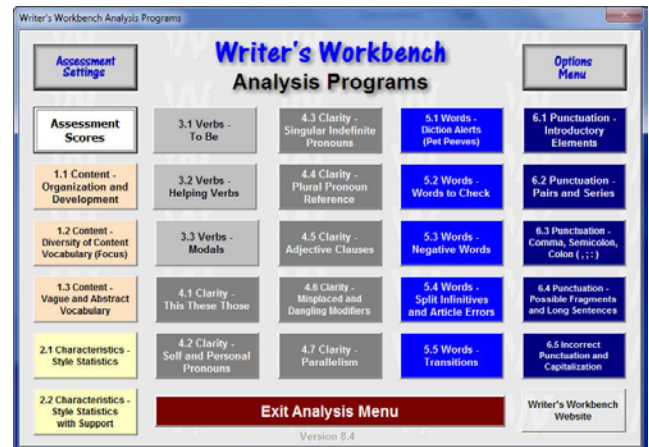
