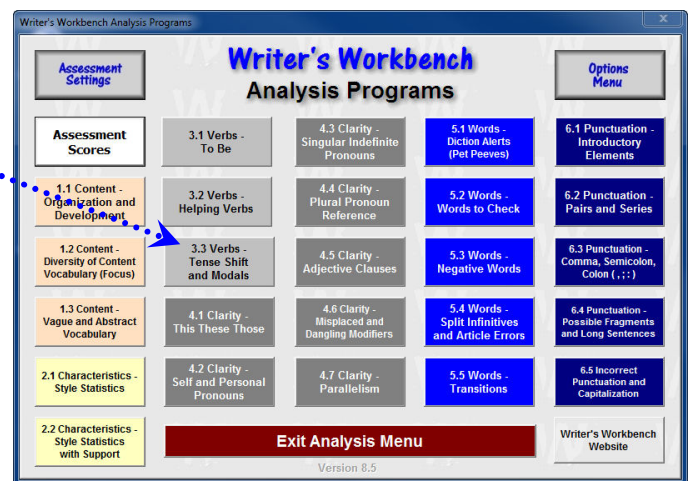
Just a quick note to alert you to the exciting new WWB Version 8.5 enhancements included with this release.

Now compatible with 32 bit and 64 bit versions of Word 2007 and Word 2010

New Analysis – "Tense Shift"

- Displayed before the Modals Analysis
- Provides a tool to help identify unintentional tense shift
- Flags past tense verbs and future tense helping verbs
- Does not flag present tense verbs
- "MoreInfo" – provides general rules and examples of inappropriate tense shift and examples of intentional tense shift




"Always use Writer's Workbench"

- Provides the ability to always load Writer's Workbench tools whenever double-clicking on a Word document (provided as an option)
- No need to double-click on the WWB desktop icon and then open the document

Other Enhancements

- Long bullet lists (over 256 words) no longer cause problems for dissertations and long documents
- More user-friendly handling of non-text characters and objects in documents
- Visual improvements in analyses
